Care Coordination and Management Program

Care coordination is a critical component to the success of an accountable care organization. With the establishment of Dignity Health Care Network, we expanded our Care Coordination and Management Program in June 2020 to include patients that meet the clinical and program criteria, including Medicare beneficiaries through the MSSP ACO Program.

On June 3, 2020, the DHCN Board approved a resolution approving the use of the Care Coordination Program and the application of the Waivers related to the Program, and determined that the Program is reasonably related to the purposes of the Shared Savings Program because the Program promotes accountability for the overall care of patients, including Beneficiaries, through care coordination and navigation services.

The Care Coordination and Management Program through the use of evidence-based medicine and data, finds and engages patients who would benefit from care coordination, navigation and complex case management, including those patients considered rising risk that could become complex in the future and those patients with chronic conditions. Care Coordinators will collaborate with the practitioner to coordinate clinical and support services for patients to decrease the potential for fragmentation of care.
